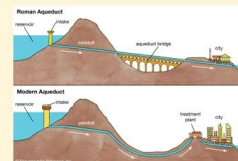

Using shading to draw 3D shapes accurately. Learning how to draw with one-point perspective and drawing buildings.



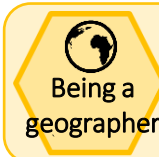
