Miss McDonnell or Mrs Rea at the gate.






During your first day at school, you will make a peg label. This will show you where to hang your coat.






There is a space inside to put your book bag. You can borrow books from school to read at home.




There is also a space in the garden room to keep your water bottle.

learning resources.




These are the
